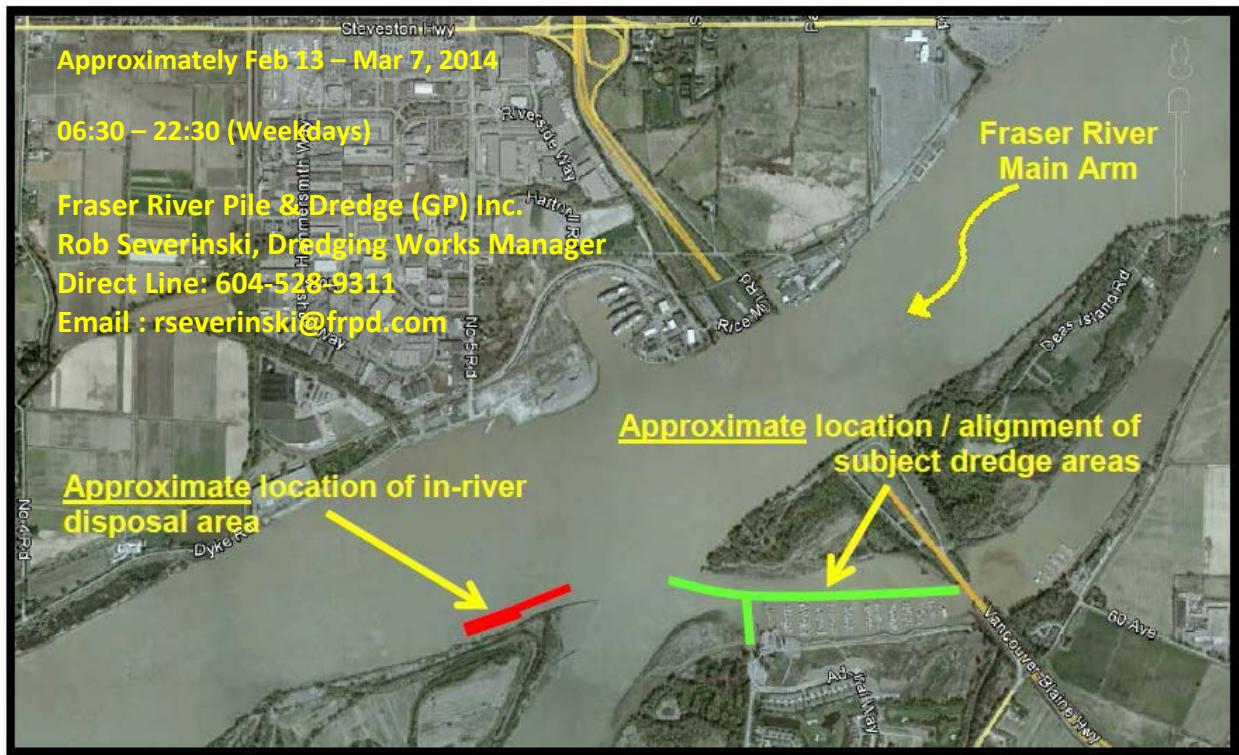


# NOTICE OF DREDGING – DEAS SLOUGH and FERRY ROAD BOAT RAMP

Port Metro Vancouver is pleased to announce, on behalf of its funding partners the Provincial Government and the Corporation of Delta, that local channel dredging in Deas Slough and the Ferry Road Boat Ramp will commence on or around February 13, 2014 for a duration of 7 to 10 days.



### Project Description:

Approx. 100,000 cubic metres of river bottom will be removed by cutter-suction dredge and disposed via pipeline directly to the in-river dispersal site. The \$1.0 million dredging project is intended to re-establish Deas Slough navigation channel design (depth and width) and remove materials around the Ferry Road boat ramp that currently impacts recreational boaters.
