20 Member present.

Minutes of last General Meeting accepted as read, moved by P/Commander Curran, Seconded by Lt. Commander Siegmund. Carried.

P/Commander Watts reported that new bent propeller trophy named Pleasure Bent was won by Commander Tony Paiger at the Graduation Party, April 29, 1966.
