Moved by Cmdr. Paiger that Fraser Squadron use the standard C.P.S. books to be ordered from National by Lt. Cmdr. Durant. Seconded Ltd. Cmdr. Durant, Carried.

Moved by Lt. Cmdr. Durant that Dominion Government publications "Small Vessel Regulations" 40¢ each, and "Canada Shipping Act, Collision Regulations" to be presented to piloting class. Seconded by Cmdr. Paiger. Carried.

Cmdr. Paiger volunteered to contact Western Marine for prices of dividers, parallel rules, and the above two Government publications.

35 Piloting Kits, 10 Seamanship kits, 10 advanced kits, 60 -1210 charts, 35 Chapmans, and one instructors kit for each of the three courses. Cheque for total cost of \$337.52 to accompany order.

Cmdr. Paiger and P/Cmdr. Watts to contact Richmond Yacht Club to make arrangements for their charge for meetings.

Moved by Lt. Couch, Seconded P/Cmdr. Watts that the next general meeting be held Thursday, October 20th, 1966. Carried.
